Application by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch, industrial organisations of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Engine Packing Manufacturers (State) Industrial Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in the manufacture of engine packing in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Chamber of Manufactures of NSW (Industrial) and one by the Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 25 November 1998.
