Application by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Domestic Workers, &c. (State) Industrial Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in or in connection with domestic work or domestic workers other than persons employed performing clerical work;

Excepting all persons employed in or in connection with hospitals, mental hospitals, public charitable institutions or ambulance work;

excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the following Industrial Committees:

Cleaning Contractors (State);
Colleges of Advanced Education Employees (State);
Crown Employees (General);
Independent Schools and Colleges, General Non-Teaching Staff, &c. (State);
Kindergartens, &c. (State);
Security and Cleaning, &c. (State);
University Employees (State).

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Employers' Federation of New South Wales and one by the Public Employment Office.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 25 November 1998.
