ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Animal Feed Manufacture (State) Conciliation Committee published 20 August 1993 (276 I.G. 345) be dissolved and there be established a new Animal Feed Manufacture (State) Conciliation Committee for the Industries and Callings of:

All person employed in the manufacture of feeds and licks for animals and/or in the crushing, grinding, preparation and/or handling thereof in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting

Engine drivers, firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers engaged in and about the driving of engines;

and excepting also employees within the jurisdiction of the following Conciliation Committees:

Domestic Pet Feed Manufacture (State);
Starch and Condiment Makers, &c. (State).

2. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.

3. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial).

4. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the National Union of Workers, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 11 December 1995.
